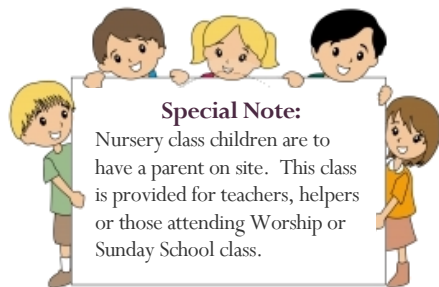


SOME WAYS YOU CAN HELP

WELCOME TO EPC NURSERY

We are aware that the nursery is the first place in the church where children experience God's unconditional love through those who care for them. Our goal is to provide a relaxed, friendly and loving atmosphere which is safe and secure.



Our clean and safe nursery is offered for children from infancy through start of first grade.

- ♥ Our Nursery is located in the courtyard area of the church.
- ♥ The Nursery is staffed by loving and competent adults and young adults so that parents can attend the Worship Service and Sunday School classes and learn without distraction.
- ♥ Our Nursery is available from:
9:00 - 11:30 am.
- ♥ Our Nursery utilizes vibrating pagers to contact parents. This way you can relax and know that you will be contacted if there is any need for your little one.
- ♥ Mother's are also welcome to nurse their infant in our infant nursery.

WHEN YOU ARRIVE

- ☺ Please check in at Nursery door, where you will be greeted by our volunteer nursery staff and receive a pager.
- ☺ Please label all items left with your child, even if they are in the diaper bag (the bag itself, bottle, preferred snacks, etc).
- ☺ Be sure you have your pager with you when you leave the nursery, and be sure to return your pager when you pick up your child.



SOME THINGS TO CONSIDER

Thank you for remembering that children with infectious diseases will want to stay home and should not be brought to the Nursery. Please be aware of these symptoms/illnesses **in the last 24 hours** including, but not limited to:

- ☺ Children must be fever free for 24 hours prior to nursery visit
- ☺ No eye discharge (pink eye)
- ☺ Respiratory infections: sinus infections or colds with frequent coughing or sneezing. *Nasal drainage that is green or yellow indicates infection. No GREEN or YELLOW allowed!*
- ☺ Hepatitis, meningitis or influenza
- ☺ Some skin infections and rashes (i.e. impetigo, ringworm, fever blisters)
- ☺ Vomiting and or Diarrhea

PLEASE NOTE

- ☞ Diaper Changes-Diapers will not be changed unless odor is an issue. Parents may be called for diaper changes.
- ☞ Toilet training— If your child is in the middle of potty training, please have them wear a pull up.
- ☞ If a child is crying we allow them to cry for 5-10 minutes and or if they are inconsolable, we will send for their parent.
- ☞ If a child develops fever while in the nursery, parents will be immediately contacted to pick up their child.
- ☞ If your child develops symptoms of infectious disease (i.e. conjunctivitis or chicken pox) after being in the nursery, please contact the church office (838-2798) so other parents can be notified of their child's exposure.
- ☞ **Please note:** *We cannot administer any medications to your child.*
- ☞ Disciplinary issues (i.e. biting, hitting, disruptive behavior) - The child will be given a warning by the nursery staff. If the child repeats the negative behavior a parent will be called in from church.
