Board of Elders:

The governing body of Escalon Presbyterian is called the Session. The Session is made up of elders and is moderated by our Pastor. The Session is responsible for the spiritual life and mission of the church and is made up of various Departments that oversee many of the ministries here at the church. These include:

- Youth Ministries (Sunday School, Youth Groups)
- Adult Ministries (Bible Studies, Small Groups)
- Mission Outreach (Evangelism, Missions)
- Church Life (Fellowship, Members)
- Trustees (Facilities, Personnel, Memorials)
- Finance (Stewardship, Budget)
- Worship (Music, Choir)

Board of Deacons:

The Board of Deacons is made up of deacons and officers elected from their body. The Board is responsible for ministering to those in need, to the sick, to the friendless, and to any who may be in distress. The Deacons are organized around four ministry commissions:

- Worship: preparing communion, flowers, greeters, lay readers
- Shepherding: providing meals for funerals, shut-ins, sick and ill
- Visitation: prayer chain, elderly visitation, card ministry
- Deacon's Fund: emergency, one-time assistance

Presbytery/Synod

We are part of the Presbytery of the West, which is a regional order of churches under the jurisdiction of the Synod of ECO (Covenant Order of Evangelical Presbyterians).

Thoughtful Theology - We believe in theological education, constant learning, and the life of the mind, and celebrate this as one of the treasures of our Reformed heritage.

Egalitarian Ministry - We believe in unleashing the ministry gifts of women, men, and every ethnic group.
